

Mission Viejo High School Choral Music New York City Trip 2019 Information April 11 - 15

Mission Viejo High School's Choral Music Program is a hard-working and successful organization that brings pride to the community. Recognizing the hard work ethics and talent level our kids have to offer, Choirs of American has personally invited the Mission Viejo High School Choral Music Program to participate in a mass choir performance at Carnegie Hall in New York City! This trip will undoubtedly provide a once-in-a-lifetime experience for your student. Only the top choral music programs throughout the nation are invited to such a prestigious event and it will allow our students to not only be a part of an amazing opportunity but also allow them to grow their experience in the arts outside the classroom. This trip will be a celebration of music, artistry, community and culture, so do not let this chance pass you by!

Cost and Payment Schedule

In an effort to maximize our programs trip we will combine musical experiences with the sights of NYC thus allowing our students a once in a lifetime trip they will never forget. To make this happen, we have decided to partner with Seachrist Travel who is known for providing high school music programs like us amazing travel opportunities at an affordable price.

The estimated cost for the New York City trip is **\$1600**. This includes transportation, sleeping accommodations, our performance at Carnegie Hall, performance/clinic/workshop with collegiate choral directors, 2 Broadway musicals, Sightseeing at major NYC attractions (Elis/Liberty Island, Ground Zero, Time Square, etc), all select meals, performance/rehearsal space, and all taxes, and gratuities.

This trip is only possible through continued support of the music program. If the choir cannot meet their donation/fundraising goals, it may not be feasible to participate in this choir trip and future tour events in general. This is in addition to the student voluntary contributions that are needed annually for continued support of the music program.

Payments should be made by check to: Mission Viejo High School Choir. <u>Please include your student's</u> <u>name on the memo line.</u> The first Payment for returning students was due Friday, May 25, 2018 and an accelerated pay schedule for students committing in the fall 2018 will be starting 9/14/18. This payment will reserve your spot on this trip and allow us to secure airfare. Payments do not include souvenirs, Lunches, spending money or extra (non-itinerary) activities that may be available during down time.

Should a student decide he/she would like to participate and the period of adding additional students to the trip list has passed, a waitlist will be offered. In the event that a previously committed student must drop out, a student on the waitlist would be offered to take their place. All payments would be required to be caught up to the standard pay schedule at the time of commitment. An accelerated payment schedule for new students or new school year trip additions will be collected in the fall 2018.

In the event of an absence of Mrs. Norris, a locked deposit box and envelopes is located at the front of the choir room for students to fill out and deposit in. Mrs. Norris will collect deposits to turn in for contributions for the trip.

Who's Eligible?

Although everyone in the Mission Viejo High School Choral Music Program is eligible to go, each student must audition due to skill level that such an event requires. Because both the Chamber Singers and Treble Choir are auditioned choirs, students in them automatically are able to attend this tour without a separate audition. All other MVHS Choral Music members must schedule an audition prior to turning in the first trip payment. To do this, please contact Mrs. Norris at <u>norriss@svusd.org</u>.

Chaperones

While we could not go on this trip without them, chaperones are responsible for the same payments and payment schedule as the students. The school requires one (1) chaperone per six (6) students. There will be one Mission Viejo High School staff member going to New York City. Should we have an excess of chaperons interested in joining the tour, a waitlist will be created. Please note: parent chaperones will not necessarily be their own student's chaperone.

There will be a mandatory chaperone meeting two (2) weeks prior to the trip as well as additional information at our trip parent meetings throughout the school year. Fundraising

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Basic Package Includes:

- Round-trip transportation between Mission Viejo and LAX (includes fuel surcharges)
- Airfare from LAX to New York City
- Subway & Bus transportation in New York City
- 1 Carry-on luggage and 1 carry-on small bag (backpack, purse, etc)
- 3 nights accommodations in the Days Inn by Wyndham Hotel New York City-Broadway
- Several meals for the duration of the trip (4 Breakfasts, 1 Lunch, 2 Dinners)

Pricing: **\$<u>1600</u>** (4 students to a room. Chaperones to be 2 to a room)

NOTE: Single Rooms subject to a \$350 additional fee

Although, we'd like as many chaperons to join us as possible, we must stick to a 1 to 6 ratio based on room pricing and SVUSD student requirements. Should there be additional spots that won't affect trip pricing; we'd more than welcome the additional travelers.
