With the trip fast approaching, here is an outline of what you need to know to make this trip successful.

Airline Requirements

Since we will not be checking any luggage on our flight, we will need to conform to the TSA and American Airlines rules and regulations regarding what we can and cannot take on board.

- 1 small Carry-Ons (purse or backpack)
- No liquids larger than 3.4 ounces (100 ml)
- 1 Carry-Ons Suitcase 14" H x 9" W x 22" L or smaller (**NOTE: any bags larger will be checked at the expense of the student and their family**)
- 3-1-1 for Carry-Ons
- No Sharp Objects
- Place an identification tag on your bag

Student Medical & Code of Conduct Requirements

- CA State issued ID (*students over age 18*) OR MVHS School ID for students under age 18
- Spending Money for Souvenirs & meals not covered by tour costs
- Photo ID with name on it (Drivers License and ASB Card will be fine)
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Cloths appropriate for Seattle weather
- Choir Music (*if needed*)
- Umbrella and/or raincoat is recommended
- Optional mask for airline travel
